As a part of an ongoing investigation into the disturbance Tuesday night into Wednesday morning, investigators from the Ames Police Department have arrested the following individuals:

Andrew Adams, age 20 of Ames, Trespass, a simple misdemeanor

Mark Ribbeck, age 20 of Ames, Harassment of a Public Official, a simple misdemeanor

David Irving, age 20 of Ames, Theft 5th degree, a simple misdemeanor, Disorderly Conduct, a simple misdemeanor, and Criminal Mischief 2nd degree, a class "D" Felony

Arrested on Ames warrant by ISU Police:

Alexander Abbinante, age 19 of Ames, Trespass, a simple misdemeanor

Additionally, Clayton Steimel, age 20 of Ames, was cited and released on two citations, Criminal Mischief 5th degree and Disorderly Conduct, both simple misdemeanors.

A criminal charge is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
